Court hearing for creditors' claims examination: **May 5th, 2020 h. 9.30 a.m.**

By order of April 2nd 2020, notified on April 6th2020, the Chief Justice Dr. Silvia Bianchi, at the request of the Extraordinary Commissioner, has set a additional credit verification hearing for **July 7th2020 at 9.30 am.**

In accordance with the content of the request, the hearing on July 7th2020 will be given priority to the examination of the liabilities of employee claims and the assimilated and related cases already received or that will be received by **June 7th2020.**

According to the information available to date, the hearing for the verification of claims scheduled for May 5th 2020 h 9.30 will be held regularly, unless several measures of the Venice Court taken in accordance with any extensions of the provisions relating to the social distance that should be adopted by the Authorities in the context of the Covid-19 health emergency.

Finally, it should be noted that, in view of the high number of claims for liabilities received at the end of April 5th, the Extraordinary Commissioner reserves the right to propose to the Judge to postpone to another hearing, even further than that of July 7th 2020, the examination of the claim that need a complex instruction and/or documentary integrations and/or cognitive insights.

Claims received after April 5th2020, other than those relating to employee and related credits mentioned above, will be examined at another hearing according to the timetable that will be ordered by the Delegate Judge.

The Extraordinary Commissioner will notify the creditors concerned in a timely manner about the resulting possible measures.
