Court hearing for creditors' claims examination: May 5th, 2020 h. 9.30 a.m.

By order of April 20th 2020, pursuant the D.L. April 8th 2020 n. 23/2020 and the Order of the President of the Venice Court of April 9th 2020, Chief Justice Dr. Silvia Bianchi postponed credits' verification hearing, scheduled for May 5th 2020, **to June 16th 2020 at 9.30 am.**

At the verification hearing on June 16th 2020 all liabilities claims received until May 17th 2020 will be examined, with the exception of all liabilities claims of employees and the assimilated and related cases already received or that will be received by June 7th 2020 which will in any case be examined during the hearing already scheduled **for July 7th 2020 at 9.30 am.**

The hearing will be held in the mode specified by Judge's Order. In particular, only the Judge and the Extraordinary Commissioner will be physically present, while creditors with a defender lawyer will only intervene in writing and the creditors without defender lawyer will intervene in writing or will ask to attend by videoconference using Teams application. Creditors interested in taking part in the hearing must submit within five days before the hearing:

- written note sent through pec to the procedure containing their observations about the hearing and the waiver of attendance;
- alternatively, only for creditors without a defender, the request to participate by videoconference. In this case creditors will declare to assume the commitment (i) to ensure that for the duration of the hearing, in the room where they will operate, no other persons will arrive and that if this happens they will immediately interrupt the connection and (ii) not to record the video call and not to disclose images and recording;

Attach find the all the necessary instructions for attending the hearing by videoconference. Finally, it should be noted that, in view of the high number of claims for liabilities received and expected, the Extraordinary Commissioner reserves the right to propose to the Judge to postpone to another hearing, even further than that of July 7th 2020, the examination of the claim that need a complex instruction and/or documentary integrations and/or

cognitive insights.

The Extraordinary Commissioner will timely inform creditors if the Venice Court will decide that additional hearings following that of June 16th 2020 should also be held in writing and by videoconference.
